Dear Parent:

Your child has signed up for a photography class next semester.

Students will supply their own photographic paper and film.

You will need a **35mm film camera that can be set manually**.

Photography is an expensive process. Be prepared to buy paper and film throughout the semester.

Photo paper is hard to find in stores, you will need to order over the internet.

Waiting for shipping is not an acceptable excuse for late work.

The school will not be held responsible for damaged or lost equipment.

Students are responsible for replacing any equipment checked out and lost/broken by the student.

Photography is time-consuming. Be prepared to spend time outside of class, shooting and printing in the darkroom.

**Do not buy C-41 processed film! Read the Box!**

### Required Supplies:

- Camera:** 35mm camera with **manual** overrides – No point and shoot cameras. **You will need a camera by January 19, 2009.**
- Film:** Kodak **black & white** T-Max film, 24 or 36 exposures, 400 asa/iso. Start with 4 or 5 rolls, or save money and buy a “brick” of film. You can buy Kodak Tri-x, or Plus-X, Ilford, Fuji, Arista or Ultrafine film as long as it is B&W and **not process C-41!**
- Do not buy B & W, C-41 processed film by mistake.**
- Photo Paper:** Any **5 x 7** RC, MG Black and White photo paper will do. You may choose the surface type – glossy, matte, or semi-matte / pearl. Buy a box of 200 sheets and save money. You can buy Kodak, Ilford, Ultrafine or Arista.
- Photo Paper:** A package of 25 sheets of RC, MG, **8 x 10** Black and White photo paper, any surface.
- Negative Sleeves:** One package of 35mm negative storage sleeves either 5 or 6 across.
- Binder:** A 2” three ring binder to store negatives and prints in; this will be checked by the teacher on a weekly basis.
- Tripods:** We have a few tripods for checkout, if you can beg or borrow one for your own use that would be great!

**\*Running out of supplies is not an accepted excuse for late work.\***

Keep track of your supplies. Put your name on everything!!

**\*Stores will not accept returns on photo supplies!\***
